

- 100 km (62 miles) northwest of Shanghai
- population? 10.58 million
- Since 514 BC, Suzhou has witnessed 2,500 years of history
- Since major economic reforms began in 1978, Suzhou has become one of the fastest growing major cities in the world, with GDP growth rates of about 14% in the past 35 years
- The classical gardens in Suzhou were added to the list of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites in 1997 and 2000
- Suzhou is often dubbed the "Venice of the East"

- Nanjing (literally "Southern Capital") is a city situated in the heartland of the lower Yangtze River region in China,
- A major center of culture, education, research, politics, economy, transport networks and tourism.
- It is the capital city of Jiangsu province of People's Republic of China.
- The city has served as the capitals of various Chinese dynasties, kingdoms and republican governments dating from the 3rd century AD to 1949.
- It is ecognized as one of the Four Great Ancient Capitals of China,
- During the Second Sino-Japanese War, the city suffered appalling atrocities, including the Nanjing Massacre.


